- *Sung Mass* at 6:50AM for the feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, preceded by the blessing of candles.
- **Blessing of candles:** Any faithful who would like their candles blessed must place them on the table provided in the main vestibule no later than 6:45AM on Friday morning. Candles to be blessed must be clearly marked with the family's name and should be picked up by the end of the day.
- All night adoration starting with a 5:00PM Holy Hour. Please sign up for adoration using the signup sheet in the main vestibule.
- *Shrove Friday Confessions:* 6:30PM-8:00PM
There will be six priests hearing confessions at the usual times on Friday as the monthly "Shrove Friday". ***No signup is required.***

- *Sung Mass* at 7:15AM
- The *blessing of throats* in honor of St. Blaise will take place after all the public Masses, i.e. following the 5:45AM, 7:15AM & 9:00AM

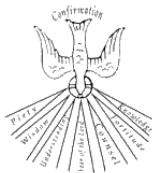
