On Sundays and ferias the organ is permitted only to accompany the chant except the 3rd Sunday, Gaudete Sunday.

Altar flowers are permitted on the 3rd Sunday and feast days only.

There will be no Rosary and Benediction on Thursday November 24, Thanksgiving Day.

Confessions will be switched from Thursday to Wednesday this week.
