DURING THE SEASON OF LENT: LITURGICAL NOTES

- votive masses and the daily requiem mass are not permitted
- Sundays are of the first class and take precedence over all solemnities
- all ferias have a proper mass
- at the ferial mass on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday everyone kneels from the "adjuva nos" until the "nomen tuum" of the tract; after the last post-communion prayer, the celebrant says the "prayer over the people" on all weekday Masses
- the commemoration of the ferial day is privileged
- Ember day ferias take precedence over second class particular feasts
- other ferias take precedence over third class feasts
- with the exception of the Fourth Sunday (Laetare), on Sundays and ferias of Lent the organ is permitted only to sustain the chant, and the altar is not decorated with flowers
- marriages cannot be solemnized until Easter Monday

Please remember that **Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday of this week are EMBER DAYS**, traditionally days of fast and abstinence, though they no longer bind under pain of sin.

OPENING 2024-2025 SMA ENROLLMENT PROCESS

- **MARCH 1:** New student applications open in FACTS at academy.smac.edu/parents with application fees waived through March 14 (includes all Kindergarten students and any new 1 – 12 grade students)
- **MARCH 1:** Financial aid applications open
- **MARCH 14:** Last day for application fees to be waived for completed new student applications
- **MARCH 15:** Application fee charged for new student applications
- **MARCH 20:** Enrollment of new students and re-enrollment of returning students open with re-enrollment fees waived for returning students through April 29
- **APRIL 29:** Last day for re-enrollment fees to be waived for returning students.
- **APRIL 30:** Re-enrollment fees charged for returning student re-enrollments
- **APRIL 30:** Financial aid applications close

NB: Application Fees (new students) and Re-enrollment Fees (returning students) are eligible for waiver as outlined above. Payment Plan Fees (labeled “enrollment fees” by FACTS) are only waived for payment plans consisting of a single payment in full before September.
