# **During the season of Lent:**

- -votive masses and the daily requiem mass are not permitted
- -Sundays are of the 1st class and take precedence over all solemnities
- -all ferias have a proper mass
- -at the ferial mass on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday everyone kneels from the "adjuva nos" until the "nomen tuum" of the tract; and after the last post-communion prayer, the celebrant says the prayer "over the people"
- -the commemoration of the ferial day is privileged
- -Ember day ferials take precedence over 2nd class particular feasts
- -other ferias take precedence over 3rd class feasts
- -with the exception of the 4th Sunday, on Sundays and ferias of Lent the organ is permitted only to sustain the chant, and the altar is not decorated with flowers
- -marriages cannot be solemnized until Easter Monday
