#### **HOST FAMILIES**

Starting next academic year, St. Mary's Academy will not be offering boarding facilities. We are already receiving inquires for "host families" to board out-of-town students (both boys and girls). If you are interested, you may pick up a copy of the Remote Enrollment Agreement from the Switchboard to review. If, after reading the agreement, you would like to host a remote boarder please contact the SMA Registrar (at ext. 475, or registrar@smac.edu).

We will share the list of names as requests are received, however, this will be the extent of SMA's involvement except for final approval from the Headmaster. It will be your responsibility to work out a custodial agreement with the student's parents.

### ACADEMY ENROLLMENT

St. Marys Academy online enrollment process for 2020-2021 begins next month. In order to enroll, payment arrangements must be made <u>during</u> the online enrollment process, unless a family's account is current and arrangements are made with accounting prior to April 1 for full tuition payments via automated bank drafts (ACH). The authorization form for full tuition payments via ACH are available at <u>www.smac.edu/ach</u> and from accounting.

# **TUITION ASSISTANCE**

There are two sources of financial aid available families demonstrating for a need: The Archbishop Lefebvre Scholarship Fund (administered by St. Mary's Academy) and the District Financial Aid Fund (administered by the US SSPX District office). The application process opens on March 15 and closes on April 30. To apply for financial aid, please apply online at the SMA Parent Portal www.smac.edu/parents and select "Apply for Financial Aid". The application takes about 20-30 minutes to complete and there is a \$35 fee. You need your 2019 tax return, your W-2, and a credit/debit card at the time of application.
