NON-ACADEMY CATECHISM CLASSES

Easter Break for non-Academy Sunday Catechism classes starts today, Palm Sunday, April 2. Classes resume on Sunday, April 23.

Mothers, Grandmothers and Godmothers: The **MOTHERS OF LU** prayer will be said today (the 1st Sunday of the month) after each Mass at the main altar rail. *“O God, grant that one of my sons becomes a priest! I promise to live as a good Christian woman and will lead my children to all that is good, wherewith I hope to receive the grace to be able to give to You, O God, a holy priest.”*

After the 7:15AM Mass on Wednesday (April 5), the chapel will be closed to allow for the floor to be cleaned and polished. **There will be no 11:15AM Mass, and absolutely no admittance in the chapel until Rosary at 5:30PM.**

CONCERNING LENTEN OBSERVANCES

Good Friday Fast and Abstinence is obligatory under pain of mortal sin.

The *law of abstinence* binds all Catholics (beginning on the day after their 14th birthday), and forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, the products of milk, or condiments made of animal fat. The *law of fasting* binds all adults (beginning on their 18th birthday until the midnight which completes their 59th birthday). The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing – as far as quantity and quality are concerned – approved local custom. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. Meat may not be eaten, but fish and all cold-blooded animals (e.g. frogs, clams, turtles, etc.) may be consumed.

Seating in the auditorium is first-come, first-served. Seats may **not** be saved for people who have not yet arrived. But if you are already seated and have to leave briefly, ask someone nearby to save your seat for you.
