CONCERNING LENTEN OBSERVANCES

Good Friday Fast and Abstinence is obligatory under pain of mortal sin.

The law of abstinence binds all Catholics (beginning on the day after their 14th birthday), and forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, the products of milk, or condiments made of animal fat.

The law of fasting binds all adults (beginning on their 18th birthday until the midnight which completes their 59th birthday). The law of fasting allows only one full meal a day but does not prohibit taking some food in the morning and evening, observing – as far as quantity and quality are concerned – approved local custom. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and fruit juices, are allowed. Meat may not be eaten, but fish and all cold-blooded animals (e.g. frogs, clams. turtles, etc.) may be consumed.

Easter Duty Reminder: All Catholics, who are of age, are required to receive Holy Communion worthily during Easter time, under pain of mortal sin. Easter time is from the first Sunday of Lent until Trinity Sunday, June 16 inclusive.

<u>Seating in the chapel/auditorium</u> is first-come, first-served. Seats may <u>not</u> be saved for people who have not yet arrived. After you have arrived and then have to leave briefly, ask someone nearby to save your seat for you.

<u>Please note:</u> Stations of the Cross on Good Friday will be in the Auditorium.
