# ROSARY CRUSADE - Starts TODAY, April 26 ("Good Shepherd" Sunday), and continues until the Feast of the Assumption August 15, 2020

In response to the COVID-19 ("Coronavirus") pandemic, Fr. Jürgen Wegner, the Superior of the U.S. District of the Society of Saint Pius X, is launching a Rosary Crusade for relief from this affliction and for all of the souls who have been affected by it.

### The intentions of this crusade are as follows:

- 1. To implore the Blessed Virgin Mary for relief from the coronavirus pandemic.
- 2. To ask Our Lord to grant mercy to those souls afflicted by the virus, including protection for medical personnel and other first responders.
- 3. To ensure the protection and growth in holiness of the SSPX's bishops, priests, brothers, sisters, oblates, seminarians, Third Order members, and all the faithful who attend its chapels.
- 4. To beg for an increase of faith, hope, and charity in these times of trials.
- 5. To strengthen the Church in the face of this affliction and for a return to Tradition.
- 6. For a greater spread and love of the traditional liturgy, especially for those currently deprived of it.

As he launches this new Rosary Crusade, Fr. Wegner also encourages all the participants to prepare a personal consecration to the Blessed Mother to be made or renewed at the end. According to the Tradition of the Church and the many requests from heaven, there is no more secure means of salvation than a personal consecration to Mary.

Please start keeping track of your rosaries. A booklet with tally sheets and instructions on how to submit will soon be made available.
