ROSARY CRUSADE - Started April 26 and continues until the Feast of the Assumption August 15, 2020

In response to the COVID-19 ("Coronavirus") pandemic, Fr. Jürgen Wegner, the Superior of the U.S. District of the Society of Saint Pius X, has launched a Rosary Crusade for relief from this affliction and for all of the souls who have been affected by it.
