Please remember that Wednesday, Friday, and Saturday of this week are EMBER DAYS and traditionally days of fast and abstinence, though no longer bind under pain of sin.

EASTER DUTY REMINDER:

All Catholics who are of age are required to receive Holy Communion worthily during Easter time under pain of mortal sin. Easter time is from the first Sunday of Lent until NEXT SUNDAY, Trinity Sunday, June 12, inclusive.

The Priests will have a private day of recollection on Thursday, June 9. There will be no exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on the priests' days of recollection during the summer.

This Wednesday, the normal 11:15am Mass will be replaced by a wedding beginning at 11:00am.
