SACRAMENTAL & CATECHISM CLASSES FOR NON-ACADEMY STUDENTS

First Holy Communion class and *Confirmation class* will begin on SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 24 in the Immaculata classrooms (located directly off the Parish Hall).

This year, the sacramental classes taught by the Sisters are reserved exclusively for those children who are preparing to receive the sacraments. **The Sisters are not able to teach any other Sunday religion classes.**

Additionally, Catechism Classes will be offered for <u>boys</u> in grades 5-12 only who are not preparing for the above sacraments; these classes will also begin on Sunday, September 24 and take place in the Immaculata classrooms.

<u>Registration forms</u> for both sacramental and boys catechism classes will be <u>available SEPTEMBER 1st</u> at the switchboard and in the vestibule.

Parents wishing to provide a catechism instruction for their children not receiving a sacrament are encouraged to enroll them in the *Catechism by Correspondence* if the Sunday class is not available.

The SSPX Sisters provide such courses for children ages 5 through High School, with lessons sent by mail, homework which is then corrected by a Sister and a personal note and holy card returned via mail back to the student.
