FEAST OF CHRIST THE KING *Today*, Sunday, October 30

Mass and Procession Information:

10:30am Solemn Mass in the auditorium immediately followed by procession.

First Communicants of last year (current 2nd grade) are asked to wear their First Communion outfits and meet the Sisters in the auditorium before 10:15am.

Eucharistic Crusaders: Please arrive by 10:00am to pick up your scapulars outside and sit together in reserved seating in the auditorium. **Return the scapulars after the procession.**

Procession Route: Leaving campus through Our Lady's Circle at approximately 12:00pm and proceeding south on Grand Avenue to Palmer Street. West on Palmer to Fifth Street, with the first Benediction at Fifth and Bertrand Avenue on Moats Commons. North on Fifth, then east on Mission Street back to campus. Return to the auditorium via the west parking lot.

SPECIAL EVENT: The life-sized marble statue of Christ the King - which will be placed on the top pedestal of the west facade of the Immaculata this week, on November 3rd - will be blessed in the Quad by Fr. Rutledge following the procession before starting the festival (between 1/1:30pm).

<u>Festival Information:</u> Directly after the procession until Vespers at 5:15pm, come enjoy the culture and cuisine of Catholic nationalities from around the globe!

NOVEMBER 1-8 INDULGENCES FOR THE POOR SOULS

Conditions for the faithful to gain a Plenary Indulgence, applicable only to the Holy Souls in Purgatory:

- State of grace at least when performing the indulgenced act
- Complete detachment from sin, even venial sin
- Confession (20 days before or after)
- Communion (20 days before or after)
- Prayers for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff (20 days before or after)
- Visit of a cemetery with at least mental prayer for the poor souls any 8 days in November. (The visits do not have to be on consecutive days.)
- Visit of a church or an oratory (on *any* day in November) with one Our Father and one Creed recited.

On All Souls' Day priests may offer three masses. The intention of the first mass is free. The second must be applied to all the faithful departed. The third must be for the Sovereign Pontiff's intentions, which are:

- Exaltation of the Church
- Propagation of the Faith
- Extirpation of heresy
- Conversion of sinners
- Concorde among Christian princes
- All other goods of the Christian people.
