- 1. Every Sunday and holy day of obligation, each prior or rector will offer his Mass pro populo, that is, for the intentions of all the souls entrusted to his care, which includes the mission chapels that are served by the priory.
- 2. Every month on the first free day of the month, a Mass will be offered in each priory for the repose of the souls of the deceased members of the Society and benefactors. If the rubrics allow this Mass will be a Requiem, but either way the date of offering will be announced each month.
