DECEMBER 25, 2022

New Year's Eve ~ Saturday, December 31:

- *I Vespers* at 5:15pm for the feast of the Circumcision .
- *Holy hour of adoration* from 11:00pm-12:00am with singing of the *Te Deum* and *Veni Creator* (both of which give a plenary indulgence) and Benediction at midnight.

Feast of the Circumcision ~ Sunday January 1:

- The usual Sunday Mass schedule will be followed.
- II Vespers will be at 5:15pm.

CHRISTMASTIDE LITURGICAL NOTES

During Christmastide the liturgical color is white.

The Preface of the Nativity is said through January 5th except at masses having a proper Preface. Then the Preface of the Epiphany is said through January 13th.

The Gloria is said even at ferial masses but not at fourth class votive masses (except for the mass of the Angels).

The daily requiem mass is forbidden through January 13th.
