The Preface of the Nativity is said through January 5th except at masses having a proper Preface. Then the Preface of the Epiphany is said through January 13th.

The Gloria is said even at ferial masses but not at fourth class votive masses (except for the mass of the Angels).

The daily requiem mass is forbidden through January 13th.
